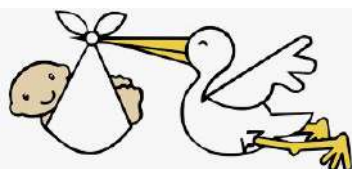

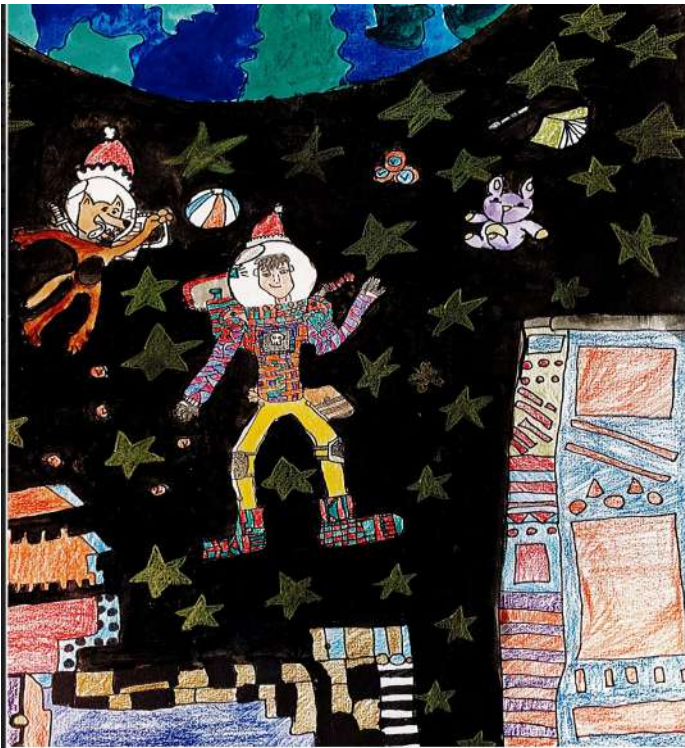


Calling all bakers/cooks

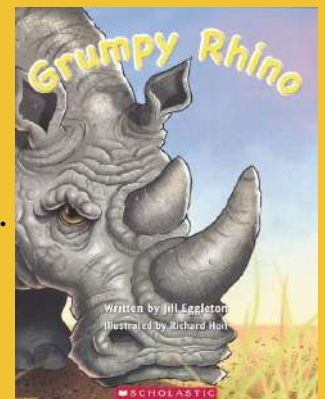
Dear Rhino
